A friendly pair of rabbits, beautifully painted in a delicate spring colour, will certainly bring good spirits and Easter joy into the home. The tinkering and painting of the two is fun and succeeds also untrained easily.

What do I need to make the papier-mâché bunny pair?

This is a craft idea that does not require a lot of crafting material. From from we have a pair of papier-mâché rabbits only; we Handicraft paint, Fabric cuts and Satin ribbon what and what is needed. Brushes, painting sponges, scissors Handicraft glue and are the tools. A sign pen is also helpful

rich. How do I paint the pair of rabbits? Before the rabbits are painted, the rabbit's clothing should be drawn
Trousers and dress are covered with fabric in the craft idea. Make a Stencil for the Fabric cut, by transferring pants and dress to a sheet Paper . Put

Both rabbits will now be primed with Handicaaft paint in grey-brown with the dress and suit of the rabbit man and woman painted white

the Stencil on your fabric and cut the pieces of

fabric.

As soon as everything is dry, paint the areas of the papier-mâché bunnies that are to be covered with fabric (dress or trousers) with Handicraft glue. Position the fabric and cut away any excess fabric Small flowers cut separately from the fabric are great accessories that can be pasted decoratively on the clothes. With Satin ribbon the waistband and the straps are decorated.

Face, ears and clothes get their contours by fine black lines with a Fineliners . Ears, cheeks and feet get that certain something with a mix of grey-brown / white colour. Depending on your taste you can finally stick a bow into the "hair" of the rabbit girl and decorative buttons. The pair of bunnies is ready!
