

Casting stylish vases

Perfect spring decorations made easy: use casting molds for creative craft ideas

Spring is just around the corner and there's no better opportunity to add a special touch to your home with homemade decorations. In this guide, we'll show you how to make impressive molds in just a few steps and create magical spring decorations in no time at all.



Step 1: Preparing your work surface and molds

Start by protecting your work surface: The VBS handicraft mat is ideal for this as it protects your surface from dirt and damage. Make sure your molds are clean and dry. This will ensure that the molds lie flat on the table so that the mixture can be poured in evenly later.

Step 2: Mixing the casting compound

Mix the powder with water until a creamy consistency is achieved. Make sure that no powder settles to the bottom when mixing the casting compound and that no lumps remain in the compound. You will need approx. 8 heaped tablespoons (tbsp) of Raysin 200 casting powder for the "Decoration plate egg shape" casting mold and approx. 2 tbsp, approx. 4 tbsp or approx. 5 tbsp of the casting powder for the different sized vase wave edge casting molds.



Step 3: Pouring the molds

Pour the prepared mixture into the molds. It is important that you always leave a rim of 0.5 cm to 1 cm free on plastic molds so that the castings can be removed more easily later. Gently shake or tap the molds on the table so that the mixture is evenly distributed in the mold and any trapped air bubbles can escape from the mixture.

Step 4: Demolding the castings

After about one hour you can demold the castings. To do this, turn the mold over and press gently on the back so that the casting can slide out gently downwards. If necessary, you can tap the mold lightly on the table to help.



Step 5: Drying and smoothing the castings

Allow the castings to continue to air dry to achieve optimum strength. Rough edges can simply be smoothed with sandpaper . This will give you a flawless finish for your decorations.

Step 6: Decorating and arranging your castings

Now comes the creative part! Decorate your castings as you wish and arrange them into a pretty spring decoration. Fill the vases about halfway with flower arrangement foam, insert the flowers and cover the rest with Iceland moss. Add little bunnies for an Easter look and your personalised work of art is ready.
