This technique allows you to create an almost invisible beginning that securely encases the filling material. Let's get started!



What is a Magic Ring?

A **Magic Ring**, also known as a **yarn ring**, is a method to start crochet projects in rounds while keeping the hole in the center as small as possible. Especially for **Amigurumi**, this technique is advantageous as it securely encloses the stuffing, such as batting. Sounds magical, right?
