Crocheted cotton pads

Instructions No. 1964

Difficulty: Beginner

Working time: 2 Hours

Enjoy the crochet fun for reusable cotton pads. The small pads are quickly Pot cloth yarn crocheted with classic. This is available in great colours and can be washed at 60°C.

This crochet idea is made with air stitches, warp stitches, fixed stitches and wales. Here we explain this row by row

- 1. <u>Row</u>: Crochet 4 air stitches and close this with a warp stitch, crochet 6 fixed stitches in it, close the row by crocheting a warp stitch in the first fixed stitch (gives a row of 6 stitches).
- 2. Row: Crochet 1 air stitch, then in each stitch (also in the first air stitch) in each case 2 fixed stitches, at the end a warp stitch in the first fixed stitch (gives a row of 12 stitches).
