

# Dragonflies from wooden balls

Difficulty: Beginner 

Working time: 1 hour

Welcome to your creative crafting lesson! Today I'll show you how you can easily make **beautiful dragonflies** yourself **from wooden balls and folding paper**. These delicate works of art are not only only great decorative elements, but also perfect as individual gifts. Be inspired by the lightness of nature and create your own flying beauty. The crafting process is uncomplicated and ideal for immersing yourself in the relaxed world of handicrafts. So, make yourself a cup of tea, grab your craft supplies and get started!

**Your creative time-out: Making dragonflies from wooden balls - Unique and relaxing**

**Step-by-step instructions: How to make your individual dragonfly**

**Step 1: Prepare the wire**

Cut a 30 cm long piece of copper wire. Fold the wire in half and twist the closed end. This will give your dragonfly stability and structure.

### **Step 2: Thread on wooden balls**

First thread a 6 mm wooden bead onto the wire. This is followed by five 15 mm wooden balls. Make sure to apply a little handicraft glue between the individual beads to fix them in place. Allow the glue to dry thoroughly to give your dragonfly stability.

### **Step 3: Making the wings**

While the glue dries, get to work on the wings. Draw wings on colored folding paper - you will need one small and one large wing for each dragonfly. Cut out both wings and fold them once along the center line to create structure.

### **Step 4: Attach the wings**

Glue the folded wings together in the middle. Then use a hole punch or awl to punch a hole in the middle of the wings. Give the wings their classic shape by opening the sides slightly. Then carefully thread them onto the wire and attach them to the wooden ball.

### **Step 5: Complete the dragonfly**

Now thread the last wooden ball and the final wooden bead onto the wire. Fix these in place with handicraft glue and leave everything to dry for a few minutes.

### **Step 6: Bend the feeler**

Finally, give your dragonfly its characteristic antennae. Use a bamboo skewer to bend the protruding wire end into two filigree antennae.
