Holzschränkchen im Patchwork-Look

Instructions No. 463

Difficulty: Advanced

Working time: 45 Minutes

In this pretty chest of drawers there is room for many small things that you would like to have at hand quickly. The drawers are covered-Paper with Décopatch, the outer surfaces with rose fabrics. Due to the delicate colours everything fits together harmoniously.



And here's how it works

Prime the complete chest of drawers white **and** when dry, accentuate the edges of the cabinet with a lnk Pads: Simply wipe over the edges with the flat lnk Pads, this gives the look a special depth

Paint the small **knobs of the** drawers with Handicraft paint in a delicate rosé, you can use the colours white and a little bit Pink mix.

For the **drawers** cut **the** Décopatch-Paper into pieces of approx. 8 x 5 cm or 18 x 5 cm. Cut the Paper with a cross in the middle, so you can pull it over the buttons. Apply Paperpatch glue to the drawers, place the papers on top and paint them well. In the next step, use double-sided Adhesive tape to glue Satin ribbon as a border.

For the three surfaces of the cabinet, cut the monochrome **Cotton fabric** to fit, fold the edges of the fabric backwards, glue with Adhesive tape (for clean non-fringed edges)

Now simply cut different fabrics and fix them with iron-on fleece on the single-coloured fabric cuts. The pattern fabrics are first ironed onto the rough side of the iron-on fleece at cotton temperature and cut out. In the second step, the protective paper from is removed from the iron-on nonwoven and the cuts are ironed onto the sand-coloured Cotton fabric. The finished fabric strips are then glued on with wood


glue.

Finally, decorate the finished chest of drawers with serrated braid or Lace ribbon and use it to border the fabric blanks.



Stick on Décopatch Paper

In the middle of the cut paper you should make a cross slit with the scalpel. This way you can apply Paper to the drawer without tearing it.



Decorative ribbons as ornamental mouldings

If you don't have a brown serrated strand at hand, you can quickly upgrade the cabinet with a narrow satin ribbon garnish glued on. Suitable colours in many cases are Taupe and Creame.




Make a ring binder right away!
