

Macramé flowers

Spring comes into our homes with these **beautiful macramé flowers** in two different sizes. They are very easy to make with **just a little material** and a **macramé knot**. Get started right away!



This is how the macramé flowers are knotted:

First cut the **yarns** for the different sized flowers as follows:

per small wooden ring: 12 threads à 20 cm

for each large wooden ring: 18 threads of 30 cm each

Knot the threads all around the rings using the **lark's head knot** (see diagram).

Comb the threads and cut them into **flower shapes**.

Tip: Iron the fringes after combing them, then they are easier to cut into shape.

Finally, glue **wooden hemispheres** in the centre.
