Solid perfume to go

Working time: 1 hour

Make your own personal perfume very easily. Our instructions show you how to make a solid perfume to take away or use at home from natural ingredients.

This recipe makes enough for two plastic jars. Beautifully packaged, the solid perfume is also a wonderful gift idea.



DIY Perfume

Fill the melting pot with water at the filling opening on the side and close it tightly with the stopper.

Now add the following to the melting pot:

- 1 tsp beeswax pastilles
- 1 tbsp coconut butter chips
- 1 tbsp shea butter

Bring everything to a melting point at a low temperature. Keep stirring in between. Then let the mixture cool down a little.

Now add a maximum of 10 drops of essential oil "Lemongrass" and stir vigorously again. Of course, you can also use another fragrance. However, please note that essential oil is highly concentrated and should therefore only be used in very small doses.

Fill the mixture into the plastic tins and leave it to harden completely in the refrigerator.

Finally, you can decorate the jars with stamped stickers.

Would you like to give the perfume beautifully packaged as a gift?

Label papier-mâché boxes with a liner and line the inside of the box with straw silk. Finally, wrap it with a ribbon and you have a personal gift.
