KNOTS USED

Lark knot Scalop knot Square knot

STEPS

STEP 1: Cut 3 cords in colour A, 2 cords of 2m and 1 cord of 1m.







STEP 2: place the cords with lark knot. The 1m cord should be place in the middle of the other two.









STEP 3: Use the middle left cord as a guide and make a scalop knot to the left with the first cord to the left.





STEP 4: Repeat step 3 with the next cord, but this time made it a little bit loose to leave a bow.



STEP 5: Repeat steps 3 and 4 to the right side.







STEP 6: Make an square knot.







STEP 7: Tie scalop knots to the middle direction and join the in the middle.







STEP 8: Repeat steps 3 to 7 until you have 3 diamonds in your feather.

STEP 9: Cut 16 cords (20cm each) and place them in the bows, 2 in the top, and three in the others with lark knot.







STEP 12: you can draw a feather in a paper and use it like a template to cut the feather. Do it when the fringers are totally dry (24 hours aprox.)









STEP 10: undo the cords one by one and brush them.









STEP 11: with the brush and the liquid starch wet the fringes and brush giving them shape.



STEP 13: Repeat all to do the second small feather in colour B.







STEP 14: to make the big feather you should repeat all the steps, the diference is that you are going to cut 2 cords of 3 meters and 1 of 1 meter in step 1, tie 5 diamonds instead of 3 and cut 24 cords of 40cm for the fringes. You can put your work with the two feathers upside down and work the third one easily.

WASHING ADVICE

Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets.

Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface. Iron on a hot temperature setting using a damp cloth. Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.
